- Memberships for 2021-22 were 378 (included 82 new memberships), last year were 372, so numbers are holding
- Pontoon was completed and bills paid. The total amount over the last few years to get this extension completed will be around the \$50,000 mark.
- Financials for end of year are being prepared by our Accountant, and are indicating a big drop in revenue of \$85 90,000 for bar/alcohol sales which reflects covid lockdowns. The club was closed for trading for approx. 16 weeks, and the yard 5 weeks, and all up we were affected for approx. 34 weeks with the vaccine pass and traffic light requirements etc. that followed. This restricted events we could run also.
- With all the restrictions and support from government subsidies we have manged to stay in profit for the second year affected by covid regulations.

YARD REPORT:

- Trolley repairs almost done and the new trolley is running again. Wheel refurbished on large trolley. A couple of wheel caps need to be repaired/replaced.
- Sump is being cleaned more often and is working well
- There is to be no washing of boats in the corner nearest the ramp as this runs off into sea all to be done over sump area
- Mike is making progress on the new cover for the dry shelter it will be made out of heavyduty shade cloth.
- We have spent approx.. \$15,000 upgrading the trolleys
- New fending is planned to be put on pontoon

- Running as usual with increasing hours as per dictated by patrons present, as people are now starting to return to pre covid ways
- It will be good to start returning to lesser restrictions and start planning for going forward now.
