Gordon presented figures & suggestive actions going forward to correct the predicted deficit that would result in a potential profit if changed.

Looking at increasing in Yard price increases. GW & TE have met with the yard team and at the potential increase in prices.

YARD REPORT:

- Back log for cradles & boats.
- One boat sold & one to be relisted and asking price to be decreased. If not sold, then boat to be stripped and to sell anything aboard.
- Numbers are up in the yard.
- Maintenance issues 1 trolley down, is currently broken. Looking at options of whether to fix or replace.
- 10-ton weight limit on haul outs. Looking at adding that if over boats are over 10 tons to ask for a weight certificate.
- Newsletter specific for yard activities to go out.
- Running out of working ladders. Keeping serviceable ones and disposing of others.
- Missing tools from tractor shed.
- New sand and filters all done.
- Discussion to be had of waste foul coming off boats and what should be done & to be added to haul out agreement.
- Lack of cleats on the wharf will need to replaced.
- Reminder that anyone requiring to stay on the jetty overnight needs to be booked via yard manger.
- Look at electrical sockets, they need RCDs on them.
- Contractors on yard, may need to see liability insurance. To be investigated.
- Block out wharf bookings for the days of fishing competitions.
- Tractor Hydraulics being looked into, but at some point, we will need a bigger tractor.
- Portaloo now in Yard for use by those in the yard. Cost of \$42 +gst per week.

- Updates for hazard board – consider maybe a bigger board.
