- Several members have now indicated trouble with the locks on the dinghy locker doors we will investigate this in new year and see if we need to put in a new system
- Steve to investigate supplying and making disposable masks available as required for painting and sanding purposes. This will be a back-up when people don't have their own. Box of 20 = \$15
- Spill Kit in yard is a general one and won't soak up oil & fuel. Cost to soak up 240L capacity = \$360 (SS)
