- BJ is having conversations with people to outsource the kitchen. There are 3 options the committee are working with at the moment. Minimum requirement is the food handling certificate (BJ). Any other suggestions welcome in the meantime. Not moving as fast as we would like.
- There is a plan to extend the bar and put another fridge in.
