

Jetty Overnight bookings: Bookings to made 3 days in advance.

- For emergency docking please call the yard manager Aaron on 0272550203
 - No overnight docking unless booking confirmation has been received from the Yard Manager.
 - Members financial account to be up to date, upon booking if the account is in arrears your booking will not be confirmed, and you will not be allowed to dock your boat.
 - All bookings are invoiced at the end of each month and are to be paid within 7 days.
 - Payment to be via internet banking.
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Jetty Movements

- Loading zones are to be kept clear and specified time limits adhered too.
 - No anchoring of any vessel/dinghy is allowed within 50meters of the wharf, gangway, ramp or jetty. This is deemed a navigation obstruction and is illegal under maritime law and can incur a \$200 fine from the harbourmaster.
 - Swimming is restricted to the inside of the jetty only. Please raise the swim ladder after use to prevent growth.
 - Please remember this is a working jetty and to stay clear of vessel movements.
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Grid use guidelines:

ALLOWED:

- Inspection and/or minor maintenance of underwater appendages – propeller/shaft/gland area, rudder stock/bearings, through hull fittings or valves, speed logs or transducers, zinc anode replacement etc.
- Remove all waste and rubbish from the site and dispose of in an appropriate manner – i.e. bins going to landfill, recycling or hazardous waste collection.

NOT ALLOWED:

- Water blasting hull fittings (as contaminated run off cannot be contained)
- Scraping down and/or cleaning of marine growth or any cleaning of hull.
- Work that creates a dust nuisance, or visible plumes or foams/scums/slicks in water.
- Antifouling application or touching up of antifoul – note best practice for antifouling paint is to allow 24hours drying time – clearly not possible between tides. Inadequately dried paint will only wash off into water.

Dinghies:

- No docking of dinghies on the jetty, docking is reserved for prepaid contracted dinghies only. (Unauthorized dinghies will be removed and locked in the yard with a \$50 fee payable for its release)
 - Uncontracted members dinghies are to be tethered to the two free SWBC supplied moored lines either side of the ramp only.
 - Please keep the beach and ramp clear at all times.
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Dinghy Lockers:

- No storage of fuel in lockers.
 - Keep lockers tidy and items within your locker space. Any items outside of lockers will be removed and disposed of.
 - Please ensure you lock the door immediately after each entry. Do not leave the door unlocked if you are not in immediate attendance.
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Car Park:

- Membership sticker must be displayed at all times. No sticker will result in your wheel being clamped and a fine payable for release.
- Trailer parking is for members trailers only – not friends or family.
- No weekend parking in the carpark for Liveaboard members in peak season 1st November – 1st March. The weekend is defined as 10am Friday through to 10am Monday.
- Adhere to parking signage
- No long term storage of boats or boat trailers in the car park.
