1. Jetty Docking Privilege

Stillwater Boating Club grants the Licensee a **monthly licence** to dock one dinghy at the designated jetty area of Stillwater Boating Club subject to the terms of this agreement.

Assigned Jetty Berth (if applicable): _____

This licence does **not** grant exclusive rights to a specific space unless otherwise agreed.

License privileges

- Disposal of small amounts of domestic rubbish in the yard bins
- Water blaster for dinghy hull cleaning as required.

2. Term of Agreement

This agreement begins on [Start Date: _____] and continues **month-to-month**, until terminated by either party with **14 days' written notice**.

3. Fees and Payment

The Licensee agrees to pay a monthly docking fee of **\$108.33 + GST**, due in advance on the **1st day of each month**. Late payments may incur docking privileges suspended until payment is received.

4. Licensee Responsibilities

The Licensee agrees to:

- Clearly mark their dinghy with name and contact number.
 - Securely tie up the dinghy at all times using appropriate lines.
 - Avoid blocking access for others using the jetty.
 - Refrain from leaving equipment, fuel, or litter on the jetty or surrounding areas.
 - Keep the dinghy in good, seaworthy condition.
 - Notify the Lessor of any damage, hazards, or safety concerns.

5. Jetty Use Rules

- Use of the jetty is at the Licensee's own risk.
 - No overnight stays or liveboards permitted.
 - Dinghies must not be locked to jetty fixtures in a way that prevents emergency removal.
 - Children must be supervised at all times.
 - The Lessor reserves the right to temporarily reassign berths or restrict access for maintenance or safety reasons.

6. Liability and Insurance

The Lessor accepts no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to the dinghy, its equipment, or any personal belongings.

The Licensee is advised to hold adequate insurance for their dinghy and third-party liability.

7. Termination and Removal

Either party may terminate this agreement with **14 days' notice**. Upon termination, the Licensee must remove the dinghy immediately.

Dinghies docked beyond 14 days after termination may be removed or disposed of at the Licensee's expense.
